What does it take to run a hotel? Here are just a few of the numbers

300

Shoe and laundry bags, made of colourful reprocessed fabrics, get "borrowed" each day from the rooms at the Andaz Delhi (www.delhi.andaz.hyatt.com).

400

Kilolitres of water are recycled by **The Leela Goa** (www.theleela.com) every day (of a total of 550KL consumed), and used in its 75 acres of landscaped gardens.

1,500

Litres of fuel are used in a year to light the lanterns at the intimate 12-villa Samode Safari Lodge, Bandhavgarh (www.samode.com).

2,000

Flowers (including 12 varieties of hibiscus alone) from the gardens of Kolkata's **Vedic Village Spa Resort** (www.thevedicvillage.com) are used to beautify the property every day.

30,000

Bottles of wine and Champagne are consumed at the **Hyatt Regency Delhi** (www. delhi.regency.hyatt.com) in a year. The hotel counts a range of vintage whiskeys among its bar jewels, including the Glenfiddich Vintage 1961, the Glenfarclas 1966 and the Remy Martin Louis XIII cognac.

Prees and plants dot the 22-acre grounds of the **The Oberoi Udaivilas**, **Udaipur** (www.oberoihotels.com). At the on-site organic vegetable patch, lettuce, parsley, basil and cherry tomatoes are grown. Fun fact: a banyan tree on the property is believed to be over 300 years old.

Rupees are spent by the Park Hyatt Goa Resort and Spa (www.goa.park.hyatt. com) in a month on the mineral water bottles placed in a hotel room.

30,00,000

Units of electricity are consumed in a year at 202-key Radisson Hyderabad Hitec City (www.radisson.com), which is equivalent to lighting up 30,000 100-watt bulbs for one hour.
